## Getting Ready For Show...

- Hauling..
  - Only tell us if you are hauling your own animal
  - Hauling your own: be sure to arrive at the Show barn by your designated time
    - Rabbits- 10AM
    - Everything else- 12PM
  - Riding on the school trailer: Double check your hauling time, make sure you are with your animal.

(load animal, go straight to the show barn, unload your animal)

# **Monday Clipping**

- IF- Clipped by an Ag teacher:
  - Sign up to be clipped (pig, lambs, goats and steers)
  - If you do not sign up you will have to clip your own
- Clipping your own:
  - You will have to rent a set of clippers after the ag teachers have finished using them on clipping days.
- LARGE ANIMALS MUST BE CLIPPED FOR SHOW

### **Show Official Dress**

- Males:
  - FFA Jacket
  - White Collared Shirt
  - FFA Tie
  - Black Slacks or Jeans
  - Black Closed Toed Shoes (boots)
  - Black Socks
- Females:
  - FFA Jacket
  - White Collared Shirt
  - FFA Tie
  - Black Slacks or Jeans
  - Black Closed Toed Shoes (boots)
  - Black Socks
- Belts:
  - you do not have to wear a belt BUT if you do MUST BE ALL BLACK BELT

### Breakdown of the show....

Parking-

-Far northeast corner of THS student parking lot
NO PARKING in CTE lot because of animal unloading

### **Arrival and Weigh in Process:**

- Doors open at 8am all animals MUST be in by <u>NOON</u>, except rabbits MUST be in by <u>10am</u>
- Weighing In:
  - Rabbits will start check in process at 10am
  - Steers will be weighed at <u>NOON</u>
  - Pigs weighed in <u>upon arrival</u>
  - Lambs and goats will be weighed at <u>12:30pm</u>
  - Once weighed you will be sent to a pen in alpha order, DO NOT remove your name tag or change pens
- Personal belongings:
  - If you need to unload anything from your car, you must do so after your animal is off the trailer
  - Any belongings need to be in a pen or kept in the car
  - Not in the aisle or alley ways

### **Show Process**

#### **EXCEPT SMALL ANIMALS**

### Classes will begin with Class 1

- Pigs have 6 classes
- Goats have 5 classes
- Lambs have 4 classes
- Steers have 4 classes

(Be listening for your name to be called

after your class for showmanship)

- 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> from each class will pen directly behind the auction block
- After all classes have shown grand and reserve champion will be selected
- Right after grand and reserve are selected "sale order" will begin
  - Total number of sale slots will be selected followed by presale animals and one alternate.
- NO MATTER your class placing DO NOT leave your pen.....
- After sale order those who were selected by the judge to return for showmanship will be asked to return. \*\*If you are not already in the sale this is another opportunity to get a sale slot.\*\*

# Thursday January 23<sup>rd</sup>

- Rabbit Show: 11am
  - Check in starts at 10am, tattoos and weight will be checked
  - After show any extra rabbits and personal items must return home with you
- Poultry Show: 1pm
  - Check in will start immediately after the rabbit show, wing bands and weights will be checked
  - Need 2 holders
  - After show any extra birds and personal items must return home with you
- Swine Show: 3pm
  - Get a packet from Mrs. Farthing

\*\*Random roll calls will be taken you MUST be at the show all day!\*\*

## Set Up for Special Rodeo

- Thursday January 23<sup>rd</sup> EVENING
  - We will need help setting up for the rodeo once all the shows are finished on Thursday
  - Please stay to help set up; the more people helping the faster we will get done!

## Friday January 24th

- Roll call will take place promptly at 7:25am
  - DO NOT be late
  - Feed your animal BEFORE!!
- Special Rodeo: 8am
  - Be sure you are signed up to work, you must be signed up via sign up genius to be excused from school
    - If you sign up but don't help you will not be excused from school or get community service hours
  - MUST be in show official dress (BEFORE roll call)
  - Will need to help tear down

### Parking-

- -School hours- Must Not block the bus area, park in northeast corner of student parking lot
- -NO parking in CTE lot the duration of the show

- Goat Show: 1pm
  - See Ms. Mohn for info packet
- Lamb Show: 2:30pm or immediately following the goat show
  - See Ms. Mohn for info packet
- Steer Show: 5pm

# Saturday January 25<sup>th</sup>

Parking-

-Anywhere in the student parking lot

-Keep the front parking lot open for buyers

-CTE lot blocked for processing trailers

• Set Up & Sale Order Meeting: 8am

- If you make the sale, you MUST attend this meeting
- Meet in room 1609
- Buckle and Trophy Presentation: 11am
  - Grand/Reserve/Showmanship/Rate of Gain Winners
  - Meet in the arena at 10:45am
  - MUST wear Show OD
- All personal items MUST be removed from the barn by 1:30pm.
  - NO ONE will be allowed in the back of the barn after the conclusion of the auction!!
- Auction: 2pm

Sale Day

- No one needs to be in the back area except those getting ready to go through the auction
- Those in the live auction; you will be expected to pass out drinks to buyers at some point in the auction
- FFA Members not in auction should be in the stands to support and cheer on other students

\*\*30 minutes at the conclusion of the auction ALL exhibitors and parents MUST be out of the barn\*\*

- Be sure to invite friends and family members to the show and sale!!
- You want to show off all of your hard work

## Responsibilities After Show..

### Small Animals:

- Must be picked up Wednesday following the show and delivered to the buyer within 1 week of pick up
- Proof of delivery form; you will get one when you pick up the animals. Needs to be signed by the buyer and returned to Mrs. Smith.

#### Thank You Letters:

- EVERYONE must write them to all the people who gave you money
- Turn in to AG teachers (to be approved) Due date 2 weeks from when you get your list
  - MUST be stamped
  - DO NOT seal the letters
- If late; 3% deduction per day for every day they are not turned in
- Any student that has NOT turned in thank you letters within 5 days will forfeit the right to show at the TISD Project Show the following year.
- If an exhibitor NEVER turns them in, they will forfeit their check.

### Live Auction Students:

- Need to deliver their pictures and show proof from buyer (with buyer signature) within 2 weeks of receiving your pictures.
- SHOW Clean Up:
  - Wednesday following show
  - MANDATORY for those that make the live auction and ALL steer raisers

## Responsibilities After Show..

- Barn Clean Up:
  - You have till Friday, February 7<sup>th</sup> to have your pen COMPLETELY cleaned:
    - Pen and drains must be cleaned and power washed
  - Friday, February 7<sup>th</sup> Final Pen check
  - Monday, February 10<sup>th</sup> Small Animal Barn and Southeast Aisle
  - Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup> Center South Aisle and Southwest Aisle
  - Wednesday, February 12<sup>th</sup> Northwest Aisle and Center North Aisle
  - Thursday, February 13<sup>th</sup> Northeast Aisle
