

Barn Rules

Don'ts



- Do's
- Clean up after your animals..
 EVERYWHERE!
- Empty shavings as far back (North) as you can in the dumpster
- Be courteous to everyone
- Pick up your trash!
- Feed your animal TWICE a day
- Throw away feed bags/shaving bags in small dumpster (not trash cans or big dumpster)
- Keep things out of the aisle.

- Dump shavings in front of dumpster
- Touch others belongings/animals or feed them (this is how disease is transmitted!)
- Leave belongings in hallways
- Leave wheelbarrows full of manure and not in right place
- Dump ANYTHING down wash rack drains (manure, feed etc.)
- PLEASE DO NOT RUN THROUGH THE BARN

Don'ts

- Close toed, completely black shoes
- Tie/scarf tucked into corduroy jacket
- White collared shirt tucked into skirt (girls) or slacks (boys)
- Zip up jacket with tallywacker tucked in
- Skirts should be knee length and the slit in the back no longer that 2 inches above the knee

- Have big earrings/jewelry
- No big bows
- Have ripped pantyhoes
- No brown boots
- Have untucked shirts
- No accessories
