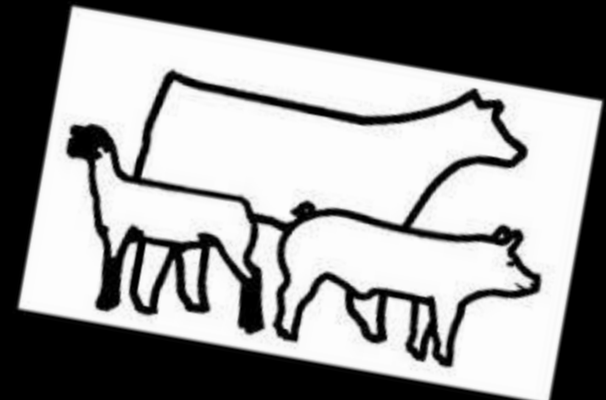
Animal Information

 - Goats- \$415
 - Broilers-\$75 for pen of 25
 - Rabbits- \$205 for pen of 4
- Barn Rent
 - Pigs- \$150
 - Sheep & Goats- \$100
 - Broilers-\$50 per pen
 - Rabbits- \$30 per pen

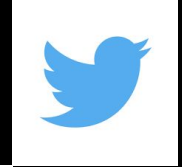
