FFA Officer Guidelines

- 1. FFA officers will be elected annually.
- 2. FFA officers shall maintain passing grades in all classes during the year he/she holds office.
- 3. FFA officers must hold a Greenhand FFA degree.
- 4. FFA officers desiring to run for an office must pass the standardized exam with a score of 70 or higher.
- 5. FFA officers seeking an office must complete a standard TMHS officer application and submit it to the FFA advisor by 2:50 p.m. on or before March 19, 2024.
- 6. The office of president shall be held by a returning officer or a senior.
- 7. FFA officers must be a FFA dues paying member in good standing and enrolled in an Agricultural Science class **both** semesters.
- 8. FFA officers may have no unexcused absences from FFA meetings or officer responsibilities. An excused absence is defined in the T.I.S.D.'s Student Code of Conduct.
- 9. Officers must attend weekly and monthly officer meetings.
- 10. FFA officers must actively participate on at least one LDE team and on at least one CDE team.
- 11. FFA officers will be removed from office if he/she receives ISS/OSS/AEP assignment.
- 12. Additional Officer Requirements; Officers MUST be in attendance for the following:
 - *See Officer Requirement Handout for all dates
- 13. All officers must have parts committed to memory before State Convention.
- 14. All officers must be in official dress for all FFA meetings.

Females: Black skirt appropriate length, collared white shirt, black hose, black closed toed shoes, FFA scarf, FFA Jacket zipped to the top.

Males: Black Slacks, collared white shirt, black shoes, black belt, FFA tie, FFA Jacket zipped to the top.

15. No officer will post/tweet anything inappropriate (including but not limited to illegal drugs, alcohol, explicit behavior, slander against our chapter or members, etc.) or anything that violates the student code of conduct on social media at any time after they have been installed as an officer of the Tomball Memorial FFA officer team. Being an officer you are in a leadership position and you must remember that at all times!
